

# **Yakutsk International Science Games**

## **Terms and Conditions**

### **Article 1- Objectives**

- 1.1. The Yakutsk International Science Games (hereinafter referred to as "YISG") is an international youth science forum to be held in the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia), Russian Federation.
- 1.2. The YISG aims to establish an international community of highly motivated students, teachers and scientists, members of public organizations and parents who are interested in science and technology, with the objectives of:
  - 1.2.1. To create and develop a continuous communicational and educational platform for the gifted and highly motivated students for their self-realization and self-development;
  - 1.2.2. To exchange experience and knowledge of the students' scientific research and projects;
  - 1.2.3. To provide multimedia coverage of the YISG and create an interactive and information web-platform for the YISG.
- 1.3. The YISG Terms and Conditions are governed by the Decree № 1330 of the Head of the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia) of July 22, 2016 "On Conduct of the International Intellectual Games" and according to the Executive Order № 490 of the Head of the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia) of June 2, 2017 "On Confirmation of the YISG Concept".

### **Article 2 - Organizers**

- 2.1. The organizer of the YISG is the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia), with the local organization support by the Sakha Junior Science Academy, and the Researcher - All-Russian Teachers Movement.
- 2.2. The YISG is also supported under the patronage of UNESCO and the International Movement for Leisure Activities in Science and Technology "MILSET"-Vostok Regional Office.
- 2.3. The YISG organization and conduct is carried out by the YISG Organizing Committee. Rules and Regulations of Competition Events are prepared and adopted by the YISG Program Committee.

### **Article 3 – Events**

- 3.1. The YISG will be held from July 8 to 15, 2018, in Yakutsk, Republic of Sakha (Yakutia), Russian Federation. Main venue is at the Ammosov North-Eastern Federal University. Working language is English. The YISG consists of three major events as described below.
- 3.2. Competition Event
  - 3.2.1. International Tuymaada Olympiads in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Informatics.
  - 3.2.2. Yakutsk International Science Fair.
  - 3.2.3. Games of Robots.
  - 3.2.4. IT-Hackathon.

3.2.5. 3D-Modeling.

### 3.3. Non-Competition Event

3.3.1. MILSET Expo-Sciences Vostok (“MILSET ESV 2018”) - an international exhibition of students’ research works in science and technology.

3.3.2. International Research School (“IRS”) of STEM-projects - research and project work by international youth mixed teams on relevant scientific and technical tasks.

3.3.3. “YISG Media Village” multimedia school.

3.3.4. “Global Challenges” International Student Science Conference.

### 3.4. Public Event

3.4.1. Yakutsk Gifted Education Conference - pedagogical symposium.

3.4.2. Public Lectures and Master-Classes of prominent scientists and cultural leaders.

3.4.3. “Future Diplomat” Game – exhibition.

## Article 4 - Participations

4.1. Participation of both the Competition and Non-Competition Events is by invitation of the YISG Organizing Committee to the recognized educational institutions / schools. Note that MILSET-ESV 2018 and IRS are subject to separate invitation through their respective systems and have different organizational fees.

4.2. The participants are of secondary school students of Grade 12 and above, and before July 31, 2018, the students have not entered any kind of higher education / university nor will their age exceed 20 years. Note that MILSET ESV 2018 and IRS have different age requirements.

4.3. For Competition Event, there is a limit of number of participants, as shown in the table in 5.1. For the Non-Competition Event, there is no limit of the number of participants. A team is composed of students, team leader and deputy team leader. A team may have 5 more accompanying persons, one per one contest event.

4.4. Organizational fee (excluding MILSET ESV 2018 and IRS) for student and team leader is:

4.4.1. Early bird registration prior 1 May 2018 – USD 50 per person

4.4.2. Late registration after 1 May 2018 – USD 100 per person

4.4.3. For school participants, the leader must provide copies of the fee payment of the students, leaders and observers (if applicable), and copies of the identification document (such as passport) by May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018.

4.5. Observers and other accompanying persons are welcome. They should pay a surcharge fee, negotiable on a case by case basis.

4.6. The cost of travel to and from Yakutsk should be paid by the participants. All local expenses, accommodation, catering, transportation, tours and other activities during the YISG will be

covered by the organizers. Visa support is provided.

4.7. The organizational fee is not refundable.

### Article 5 – Results and Awards

5.1. For the Competition Event, the following table gives an overview of the number of participants of the event. A team entry should comprise participants from a single educational organization.

5.2. For team entry, the final result is based on the total scores in all events listed in the table above.

5.3. All participants are awarded with certificate. Individual winners are awarded with medals, diplomas and prizes. The winning team is awarded with YISG Grand Cup and prize money.

5.4. The procedure for determining the individual and team winners should be approved by the YISG Program Committee.

6.1. The YISG Organizing Committee reserves the right to change the Terms and Conditions when appropriate.
